

**Law Enforcement Officer – MGT (22093)
Federal Reserve Board**

Description: The Law Enforcement Officer is part of the team that protects and provides a safe and secure environment for Board staff and others on Board property on a 24 hour, seven day per week basis. The incumbent will learn to staff security posts, conduct patrols, enforce Board Security policy, and screen visitors via the magnetometer, x-ray, and hand held metal detector. The incumbent works shift work to include nights, days, weekends, and holidays and must be able to work overtime with or without advance notice. The incumbent is required to become knowledgeable of and conform to all applicable laws, Board policy, and Unit policy and procedures. Develops judgment to implement and enforce security policies and procedures.

Qualifications: Requires a high school diploma or GED. Must have good oral and written communication skills, plus a strong commitment to customer service. Requires a valid motor vehicle operator's license and acceptable driving record, both of which must be maintained. Requires the ability to carry and use a firearm in accordance with unit, board and system requirements. Must meet the Boards standards for employment, including suitability. Must submit to and pass drug testing. Must successfully pass a background investigation and successfully complete all of the Boards mandated initial training and fitness for duty standards for law enforcement officers. Must continually satisfy the Boards training and firearms qualification standards.

Must be at least 20.5 years of age at time of application. Must meet the medical standards for the job and successfully complete a comprehensive screening which will include a physical, psychological evaluation and a medical examination to determine ability to safely perform the essential job functions. Must be able to wear the issued uniform and wear and use issued gear including defensive and protective equipment such as a baton, handcuffs, CPR mask and WMD protective mask while performing his/her duties.
