Job Summary:

Work closely with the public and University units to identify and solve community problems. Make presentations to citizens and groups. Patrol a specified area on foot or utilizing a patrol vehicle. Respond to calls related to the protection of life and property, traffic collisions, and other emergencies. Evaluate and control violent situations. Enforce federal and state laws, and University regulations. Make arrests for violations of laws; search, fingerprint and transport prisoners. Conduct preliminary and follow-up investigations of criminal incidents, disturbances, hazardous incidents, vehicle collisions, and casualties. Operate vehicles under hazardous conditions. Collect and preserve evidence and found property. Interrogate suspects and interview victims, complainants, and witnesses. Check buildings for physical security. Direct traffic and write traffic citations. Prepare written and computer-generated reports. Participate in on-going training. Prepare cases and testify in court. Execute assigned duties pursuant to University and Department policy and procedures.

Physical Demands:

Lift a minimum of 50 pounds overhead.

Lift and drag a 165 lifelike dummy a minimum of 32 feet.

Climb and go over a 6-foot fence.

Climb over and pull up oneself over obstacles; jump down from elevated surfaces; climb through uneven or narrow surfaces and using body force to gain entrance through barriers.

Work Environment:

Must pass an extensive background investigation, including criminal history and identity check and have no felony convictions pursuant to Government Code Section 1029-1031.

Must pass comprehensive medical and psychological pre-placement examinations as established by the University and by State law for police officers.

Must pass a polygraph examination.

Position is a mandatory reporter for known or suspected child abuse and requires that a statement acknowledging the requirement to report child abuse be signed.

Minimum Qualifications:

The following items must be met:

- Be (by the date of appointment) at least 21 years of age.
- Not have been convicted of a felony.
- Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.
- Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor crime that would affect your ability to possess/carry firearms.
- Be a United States citizen.
- Be a high school graduate of a U.S. high school, possess a GED, a two or four-year degree from an accredited\* college or university.
- Must possess a current California issued POST Basic Certificate.
- Lateral candidates only, currently employed or recently retired as a police officer.
- Possess a Class "C" California driver's license.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Knowledge of University regulations.
- Current or recent University of California affiliation as a student or staff member.
- Graduation from a POST approved police academy or employment as a peace officer by a law enforcement agency as defined in Penal Code section 803.1 or 803.2 (subsection a-d)
- Knowledge and understanding of current police practices, protocols and procedures.
- Knowledge and understanding of the workings of the California criminal justice system.
- Knowledge and understanding of local, state and federal laws applicable to the police function generally, and to the University of California police function specifically.
- An associates or greater degree in criminal justice or related field.
- Proficiency with use of a police mobile-data computer.
- Proficiency with the use of a police radio for tactical communication purposes.
- Ability to express oneself clearly in writing and speech.
