THE COMMUNITY & ORGANIZATION

The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport
Authority is conveniently located between
a cluster of diverse communities with excellent schools, outstanding municipal services,
and exceptional recreational facilities. Stationed in
Burbank, and only minutes away from Hollywood, the
Airport is home to great weather, nearby beaches, and easy
access to major freeways. Originally opened in 1930 as United
Airport, the Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority served
as a hub for regional air travel and played a key role in the Golden
Age of Hollywood.

Over the years, the airport underwent several name changes, including Union Air Terminal and Lockheed Air Terminal, reflecting its association with the nearby Lockheed Aircraft Company. In the post-World War II era, the airport experienced significant growth and modernization, playing a crucial role in the development of commercial aviation in Southern California. In honor of the legendary entertainer and humanitarian Bob Hope, the airport was officially renamed Bob Hope Airport in 2003. In 2017, the airport was rebranded as Hollywood Burbank Airport to better reflect its location and serve as a more recognizable gateway to the entertainment capital of the world. Today, the airport continues to evolve to meet the needs of modern air travel, providing essential services to both domestic and international travelers while maintaining a connection to its rich aviation history.

THE DEPARTMENT

The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority Police Department (BGPAAPD) has a long-standing commitment to the safety and security of travelers, employees, and the community at the Hollywood Burbank Airport. Over the years, the department has actively engaged with the local community and airport stakeholders through community outreach programs, educational initiatives, and events. Today, the BGPAAPD continues to prioritize its mission of providing a secure and welcoming environment by collaborating with federal agencies like the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to maintain the highest levels of aviation security.

The department's ongoing dedication to safety ensures that the airport remains a vital transportation hub in

Southern California. BGPAAPD has a

rich history of keeping the Hollywood Burbank Airport and its surrounding areas safe and secure. Established in 1978, the department has expanded and modernized its operations over the years to address evolving threats to aviation security. In





THE POSITION


The Deputy Police Chief plays a crucial role in ensuring the effective and efficient delivery of law enforcement services, maintaining a high level of security, and fostering positive community relations within the airport authority's jurisdiction. This senior leadership role assists the Chief of Police in planning, organizing, and directing all aspects of police operations and administration. Primary duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Assisting the Chief of Police in setting strategic goals and objectives for the department.
- Providing strong leadership and direction to sworn and civilian personnel.
- Overseeing and coordinating daily activities of departmental divisions, units, and staff.
- Implementing policies, procedures, and best practices to enhance the department's efficiency and effectiveness.
- Managing and supervising law enforcement operations, including patrol, investigations, traffic enforcement, and special operations.
- Ensuring adherence to legal and regulatory requirements while carrying out law enforcement duties
- Responding to critical incidents, emergencies, and major events as needed.

 Collaborating with other law enforcement agencies, airport stakeholders, Federal **Emergency Management** Agency (FEMA), California Governor's Office of **Emergency Services Cal-**OES, & U.S. Military to maintain security and safety.

This position will evaluate staff performance and provide feedback, and will oversee recruitment, selection, and training of police personnel.

The Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport Authority Police Department is seeking an experienced, strategic, and compassionate candidate to serve as the next Deputy Police Chief. The Deputy Police Chief will rely on their courageous leadership skills to drive the Department forward, staying current with new legal, technological, financial, and societal developments. The ideal candidate will possess a deep knowledge of the principles and practices of modern municipal police administration, personnel management, leadership, administration, and community relations; technical and operating principles, practices, and techniques of law enforcement and crime prevention; and police requirements and limitations on police authority. A caring individual that has a proven track record of successful mentorship and outstanding character and integrity is desired. The successful candidate

approaches day-to-day operations with an optimistic, can-do attitude, with a focus on end results and continuous improvement. The incoming Deputy Police Chief will know how to foster healthy internal discussions to arrive at the best outcomes as one cohesive team. An individual who will lead by example, who is highly active in the community while being easily accessible to all stakeholders and staff is essential

The ideal candidate will also have the ability to plan, implement, and manage department divisions while motivating and developing departmental staff. The ideal candidate will have a demonstrated commitment to community-oriented policing principles, strong leadership, and interpersonal skills, along with excellent written and verbal communication abilities. The incumbent will have knowledge of federal, state, and local laws and regulations related to law enforcement and the ability to work collaboratively with diverse stakeholders.
