Certification:

The successful candidate (if non-Iowa Certified) must pass a physical agility test, cognitive exam (POST test), psychological examination (MMPI – II), physical examination, and drug screen.

Residency:

The City requires that the successful candidate live within the city limits within a reasonable amount of time. The City <u>may</u> consider a candidate who currently lives/owns a home in the Des Moines Metro area.
